## Field Monitor Instructions - Area 1C 2025 League Playoffs

- 1. Region where the field is located, please provide tables, chairs, and hopefully shade for the monitors.
- 2. Place check-in tables near the entrance to the field, or a location easily identifiable by the teams.
- 3. There will be a binder per location, containing the rosters of the teams/division, highlighters, and wristbands.
- 4. These rosters will be used to check in the teams (coaches will have their own rosters, but the ones in the binders are the official ones to use).
- 5. When checking in a team, collect 4 fully completed lineup cards from the coach, verify each players' birthdate with the player, then give the player a wristband; if a player is NOT on the roster in the folder, that player **WILL NOT PLAY**.
- 6. Confirm the players' names from the roster with those on the lineup cards
- 7. Use the highlighter to draw a line under the name of the last player on the game card; no player names should be added below the highlighted line.
- 8. Hand the lineup cards back to the coach.
- 9. If a player is absent when the team check in, place a dot on the game cards (all 4) to the left of the player's name; that player will have to come to the check in table, with the lineup cards, go through the check in process, receive a wristband, and have you put a check mark over the dot next to the name.
- 10. Wristbands need to be worn during the entire tournament; if a player loses a wristband, the player has to go to the monitor table with the coach and go through the check-in process again.
- 11. At the end of the game, the referees will submit photos of the game cards to <a href="league@ayso1c.org">league@ayso1c.org</a> and will hand them to the field monitors
