

AYSO Area 1C Key LOTG Changes for 2022-2023

Changes associated with the number of substitutions are not included.

1. Law 8 – The Start and Restart of Play

Clarification that the referee tosses the coin to determine the 'ends' and kick-off "the referee tosses a coin and the team that wins the toss of a coin decides (...)"

2. <u>Law 10 – Determining the Outcome of a Match</u>

Clarification that a team official may be cautioned or sent off during kicks from the penalty mark

"A player, substitute, or substituted player or team official may be cautioned or sent off during kicks form the penalty mark."

3. Law 12 – Fouls and Misconduct

- A. Clarification about handball offences by the goalkeeper in their own penalty area "Where a player denies the opposing team a goal or an obvious goal-scoring opportunity by a handball offence, the player is sent off wherever the offence occurs (except a goalkeeper within their penalty area)."
- B. Clarification about the position of a free kick awarded when a player leaves the field of play without the referee's permission and then commits an offence against an outside agent
 - "(...) If the referee stops play for an offence committed by a player, inside or outside the field of play, against an outside agent, play is restarted with a dropped ball unless a an indirect free kick is awarded for leaving the field of play without the referee's permission; the indirect free kick is taken from the point on the boundary line where the player left the field of play."

4. <u>Law 14 – The Penalty Kick</u>

Clarification about the position of the goalkeeper before and when a penalty kick is taken

"(...) When the ball is kicked, the defending goalkeeper must have at least part of one foot touching, or in line with, or behind, the goal line.
